#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- Late entries in any section will not be accepted
- No cattle on the grounds until after 1:30pm Friday 6<sup>TH</sup>
- All exhibitors and competitors compete entirely at their own risk and the Society is not responsible for any injury, damage or loss sustained by an exhibitor or competitor.

Changes to the program and regulations can be made at the discretion of the Chief Steward on the day

#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- All cattle to be on the grounds by 7.30AM on the day of the show and remain until after the Grand Parade. Prizewinning animals must participate in the Grand Parade.
- 2. All cattle on the grounds should be secured with a neck collar when not being paraded.
- Bulls over 12 months old must have a nose ring and be led with a staff or two leads. All bulls must be always under strict control. All cattle are to be led. All cattle 8 months and over must have a nose clip or ring and be led with 2 leads.
- 4. All bulls over six months must be tied up immediately on entering the grounds. Offenders against this rule are liable for expulsion from the competition.
- 5. Only 1st prize animals can compete for Champion. The animal placed 2nd in the Class can compete for Reserve Champion.
- If any doubts arise in the mind of the Judge in any class, the matter will be referred to the Chief Steward for clarification.

- 7. All exhibits must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor, except where otherwise stated. All exhibits from a partnership must be the bonafide property of the firm exhibiting same & no animal owned by an individual member of the firm will be eligible for a prize unless it is exhibited in his/her own name
- 8. The classification of all animals competing in this section shall be determined by the production of age certificates. The age of all the cattle must be the actual age as at October 1st 2019. Entry forms must be completed in full detail & pedigree of stock supplied. One substitute entry allowed in pen and group classes.
- 9. All exhibits in pen & group classes must have been entered in single classes.
- An animal entered & not exhibited cannot be replaced by any other animal other than the substitute entry in pen or group classes and then only with the express permission of the Chief Steward.
- 11. In Paradors competitions, 6-19-year-olds are to parade heifers and steers under 20 months only as per ASC rules.
- 12. All cattle must be made available for inspection to persons nominated by the Society or Breed Society
- All persons leading exhibits in the Judging Ring must be suitably attired.
- 14. The Society will not under any circumstances be responsible for any loss, mis delivery or any damage thereto of livestock at the Society's Exhibition.

### DAIRY CATTLE RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Cattle must be EBL Free. Pestivirus tested.
- 2. No cattle on the grounds until after 1:30pm Friday
- 3. All Animals must be registered in the Herd Book or their Respective Breeding Society.
- 4. All Animals Not of Age for Registration must be registered in accordance with the Rules & Regulations of their respective Breeds.
- 5. All Livestock must be the Bona Fide Property and in the Possession of the Exhibitor at the time of entry. Where reasonable grounds exist for doubts, the Committee may demand a Statutory Declaration as to the Bona Fides of any exhibit from the Exhibitor.
- A class in which the Exhibit comprises one Animal shall be a Single Class, a class in which the Exhibit comprises more than one Animal shall be a Group.
- 7. A Heifer is defined as being under three (3) years of age and not having had a calf before the date of the Show.
- Any Cow entered in a Dry Class if at any time of competition may compete as a Wet Cow or vice versa. Cows which are entered in a Dry Class which are in milk on the Day of Judging must be miked out immediately prior to entering the Judging Ring.
- 9. A Dry Cow is defined as having completed nine (9) months lactation or is six (6) months in Calf at time of entry.
- 10. All Stock must Parade in the grand Parade unless granted special exemption by the Chief Steward.
- 11. All Dairy Cattle Exhibitors to wear Breed Judging Uniform.
- 12. Dairy Cattle to be Judged on Saturday order of Classes as per Schedule.

- 13. No Animal other than an Exhibit shall be displayed or exposed for sale on the Showground.
- 14. If, in the opinion of the Veterinary Surgeon of the Society, an animal on the Showground shall be injured or be so affected by sickness, disease or other ailment as to warrant its destruction or its removal from the Ground, as the case may be, the Society shall be entitled to have the anima destroyed/removed from the Ground and/or shall be entitled to request Owner to forthwith remove the animal from the Ground. All costs incurred by the Society shall be for the account of the Owner and shall be refunded to the Society.
- 15. No Cattle can compete in any Classes additional to those that are entered on the Entry Form.
- In addition, all Entries are subject to the General Rules & Regulations of the Society.
- 17. All Exhibitors must be on the ground by 7:30 am on Saturday ready for Judging to commence at 08:30 am.
- 18. Judges decision is final.

#### INTERBREED DAIRY SHOW

- 1. Heifer Under 12 months old
- 2. Heifer 12 months and under 18 months old
- 3. Heifer 18 months and under 2 years dry

#### Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion

- 4. Heifer 2 to 3 years dry
- 5. Heifer Under 2 years in milk
- 6. Heifer 2 years and under 2.5 years in milk
- 7. Heifer 2.5 and under 3 years in milk
- 8. Heifer under 3 years best udder and attachment.

#### Intermediate champion and Reserve Intermediate Champion

- 9. Pen of 3 heifers under 3 years old.
- 10. Cow 3 years and under 4 years in milk or dry
- 11. Cow 4 years and under 5 years in milk or dry
- 12. Cow 5 years and under 7 years in milk or dry
- 13. Cow 7 years and older in milk or dry
- 14. Cow over 3 years Best Udder and Attachment

#### Champion Cow and Reserve Champion Cow

- 15. Pen of 3 cows over 3 years old
- 16. Sires' progeny, any 2 animals by one sire.
- 17. Maternally related. Any 2 daughters or granddaughters.
- 18. Exhibitors group. Comprised of 2 animals over 3 years and 2 animals under 3 years.

#### **Dairy Youth Section**

Age of handler to be calculated as on the day of the show. No entry fee required.

- Fancy Dress- best dressed child and/or calf, open to all competitors in the junior handler classes.
- Under 5 years of age assisted handler, child to be accompanied by an adult. Entrant is not eligible to compete for the champion handler.
- 3. Handler Under 7 years of age.
- 4. Handler 7 years and under 10 years
- 5. Handler 10 years and under 14 years
- 6. Handler 14 years and under 18 years
- 7. Handler 18 years and under 25 years
- 8. Best prepared and presented. To be judged for overall presentation of the heifer and the handler.
